#### **BEFORE YOU GO**

- Check NADA/local listings for value
- Run VIN: Confirm title, year, & history
- Prep documents: Bill of sale, title transfer info, insurance quote.

#### Ask the seller:

Why selling? Maintenance/repair history?

#### FIRST IMPRESSIONS

- Visual Check: Look for mismatched paint, zip ties, rust, or leaks.
- Docs Review: Verify title, service records, and accident history.

#### **FULL INSPECTION**

#### **Cold Bike Check**

- Oil: Level, color, no metal particles
- Chain/belt: Proper tension, no rust.
- Tires: Tread depth, cracks, age.
- Suspension: Smooth operation, no leaks.
- Frame: Straight, no welds or cracks.
- Lights/signals: Working, no exposed wires.

#### Startup/Test Ride

#### Startup:

- Cold start should be smooth. Smoke: Blue (oil), White (coolant), Black (fuel).

#### **Test Ride:**

- Brakes firm, gears shift smoothly.
  No pulling, grinding.
- pulling, grinding, or suspension clunks.

## MAJOR RED FLAGS

- · VIN tampering or mismatched numbers.
- Frame damage or fresh welds. Leaks, burning smells, or crash
- signs (scrapes, bent parts). Inconsistent or missing maintenance history
